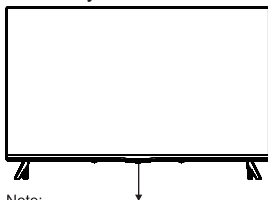

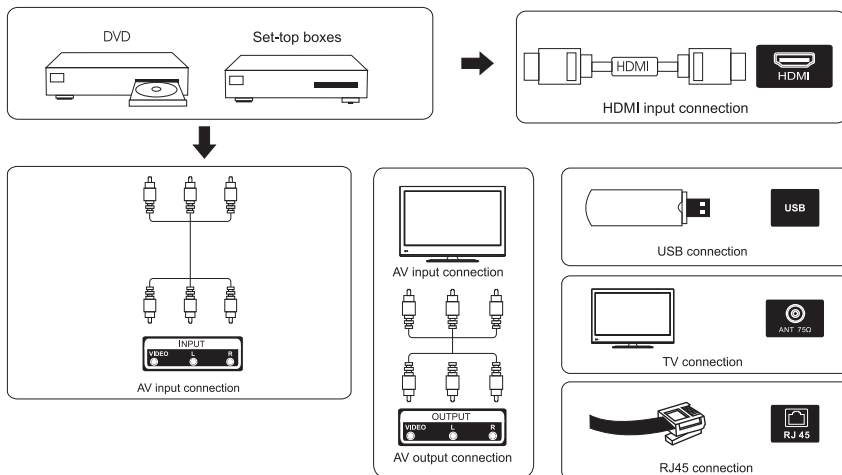

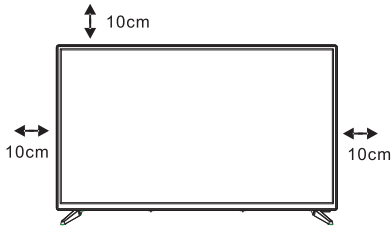

	<b>AV input</b> External AV Signal Input		<b>HEADPHONE JACK</b> Plug earphones into jack for private listening. Overrides speakers.
	<b>CI SLOT</b> The card reader input CI (common interface) this requires CAM (conditional access module) used for pay TV.		<b>USB input</b> Connect a USB device here to play its media files or to record programs via the PVR function.
	<b>HDMI input</b> Digital signal input from HDMI video connector.		<b>OPTICAL output</b> Connect the SPDIF receiver.
	<b>ANT 75</b> Connect the antenna/cable tv input (75VHF/UHF)		<b>RJ45</b> Connect the Internet.

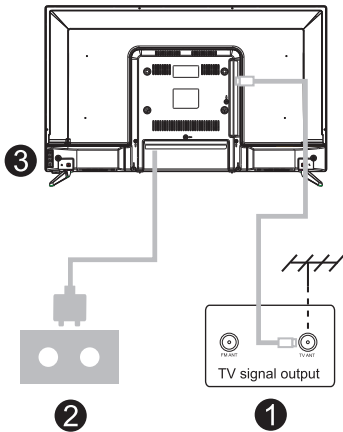


## Setup your TV

1. Put your TV in a place that can support the weight of the TV.

To avoid danger, please do not assemble the TV near water or extreme heat (such as a furnace, light source, or candle.)

Do not block the ventilation on the back of the TV.



## Connect signal source and power

2. Connect the antenna cable to the RF connection on the back or side of the TV, and/or the signal source HDMI cable to the HDMI input(s) on the rear or side of TV. Plug the TV into the wall power outlet (AC120V~ 60Hz).

## Turn on the TV

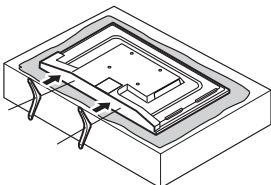
3. Connect the power supply, enter the standby mode (red light), press the power button of the TV or the power button on the remote control to turn on the TV.

# TV Stand Installation Instructions

1. Open the carton and remove the TV, accessories, and the feet.
2. To avoid damage to the TV, place on a table, face down on a soft surface. The feet are attached to the TV with provided screws, or are attached by snapping into the cabinet till you hear the click.
3. Ensure the feet are tightened/snapped-in securely. Do not overtighten.

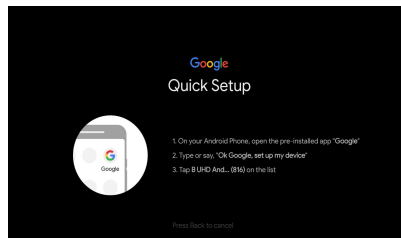
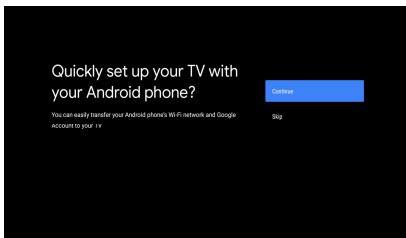
### 1.1 Language select

3. Tap the model name on the list.



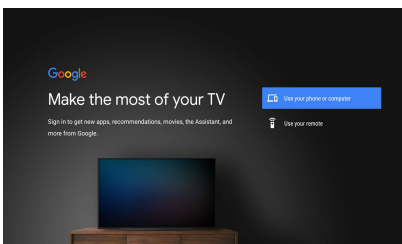
### 1.3 Configure the network

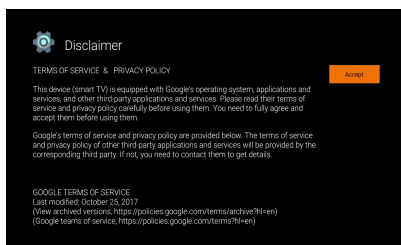
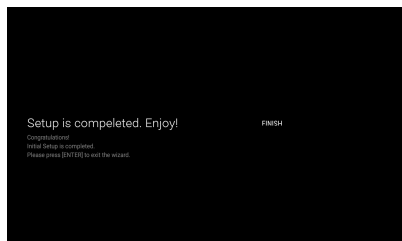
## 1.11 TV Channel Setting

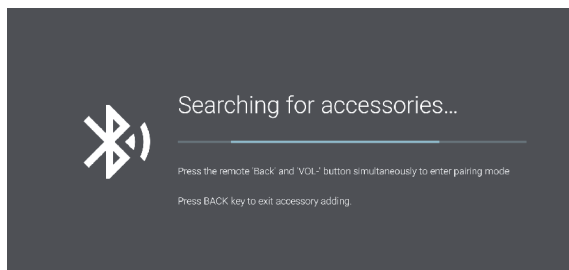
## 1.13 Pairing Bluetooth Remote

-> Press on remote control to skip the pairing mode.



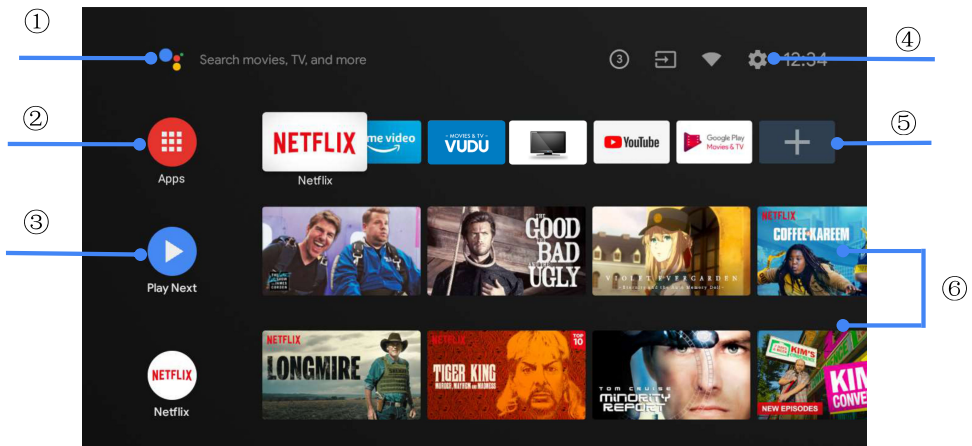

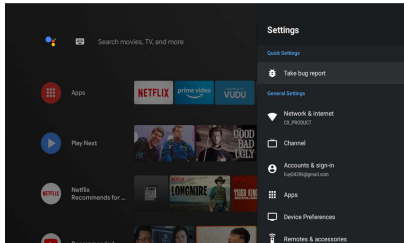

## 3.Settings

- > Press 【OK】 to enter.



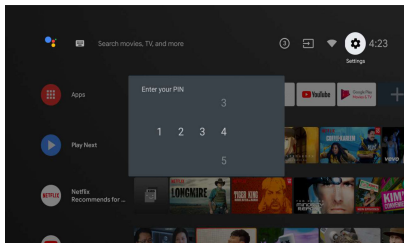
### 3.1 Network & internet

- > Press ^/v on remote control to select Channels Blocked, Program Restrictions, Inputs Blocked and Change PIN.

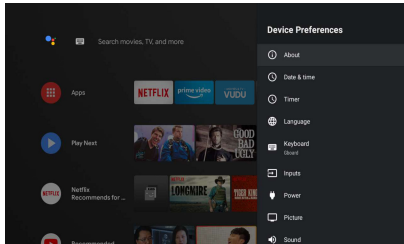


### 3.3 Device Preferences

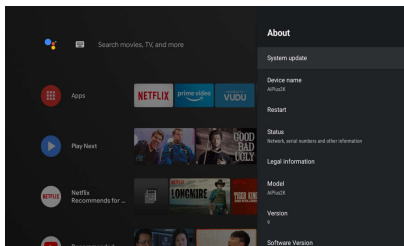


## 3.3.1 About

If **reset is selected**, it will erase all data from your device's internal storage, including: your Google account, **system** and app data and settings, and downloaded apps.

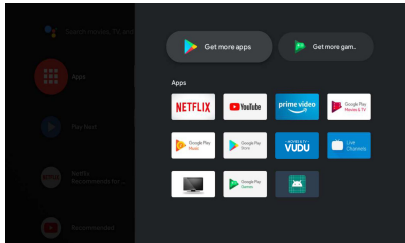
-> Press **▲/▼** on remote control to select “Reset”.

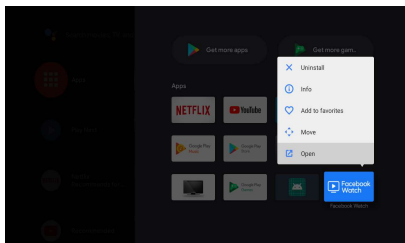

- > **Press 【OK】** to uninstall.

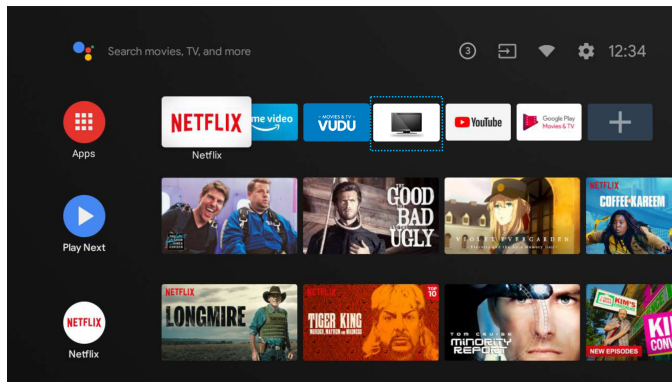

No power	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check if the AC cord of TV is plugged in or not. If there's still no power, please disconnect the plug, and reconnect to the <b>outlet</b> after 60 seconds. Turn the power back on.</li> </ul>
Signal not received properly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Double or phantom images may appear on your TV if there are high buildings or mountains close to where you are. You can adjust the image thru manual operation: consult <b>antenna instruction manual</b> adjust the direction of the external antenna.</li> <li>• If you use an indoor antenna, signal reception may be more difficult under certain circumstances. Adjust the direction of the antenna for optimum reception. If this does not improve reception, you may have to switch to an external antenna.</li> </ul>
No picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check if the antenna at the back of the TV is connected properly.</li> <li>• View other channels to see if the problem still occurs.</li> </ul>
Video appears with no audio	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Try increasing the volume.</li> <li>• Check if the TV's sound is on mute or not.</li> </ul>
Audio is present, but video does not appear or is discolored	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Try adjusting the contrast and brightness.</li> </ul>
Static noise affects video and audio quality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check if the antenna at the back of the TV is connected properly.</li> </ul>
Broken lines on screen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Electrical appliances such as hair dryers or vacuums etc. may be interfering with your TV set. Switch these appliances off.</li> </ul>
Remote doesn't work	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Try using the remote in a shorter distance from the TV. Check if the placement of the batteries is correct, or try using new batteries with the remote control.</li> <li>• The TV will go into Standby mode if it receives no response in a few minutes.</li> </ul>
No video (PC mode)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Please check if the cable is connected to the VGA port correctly, or if the cable is bent <b>or damaged</b>.</li> </ul>
Vertical line blinking (PC Mode)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Enter the main menu, and adjust the vertical placement to eliminate the vertical line.</li> </ul>
Horizontal tearing (PC Mode)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adjust the horizontal placement of the screen to clear any horizontal lines.</li> </ul>
Screen is too bright or dark (PC Mode)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adjust the brightness or contrast in the main menu.</li> </ul>
No response from the PC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check if the PC's display resolution is set to a compatible resolution for the TV.</li> </ul>
Lines appearing when a device is connected to the RCA port	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make sure you are using a cable <b>which is not bent or damaged</b>.</li> </ul>
Problems are unresolved	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Unplug the power cable and wait for 30 seconds, then reconnect to the socket. If problems still persist, do not attempt to repair the TV by yourself. Kindly contact customer service 618-392-3456.</li> </ul>

- ① Switches the TV between on and standby mode

  - Play the last/next program
  - Play/Pause/Stop program

- ⑧ Menu
  - Displays the OSD (On Screen Display) menu
- ⑨ Navigation buttons
  - Cursor UP/LEFT/RIGHT/DOWN
- ⑩ Back
  - Press to move back through menus

  - Exit the OSD menu
